Olympic Solidarity is.....



The body mandated by the IOC “to organise assistance to the National Olympic Committees, in particular those which have the greatest need of it.

This assistance takes the form of programmes elaborated jointly by the IOC and the NOCs, with the technical assistances of the IFs, if necessary”.

(Rule 5, Olympic Charter)

Olympic Solidarity Mission



To organise **assistance to NOCs**, in particular those with the **greatest need** of it, in order that NOCs may **fulfil their responsibilities** to the Olympic Movement.

NOCs & IFs Mission



NOCs

The mission of the **NOCs** is to develop, promote and protect the Olympic Movement in their respective countries, in accordance with the Olympic Charter.

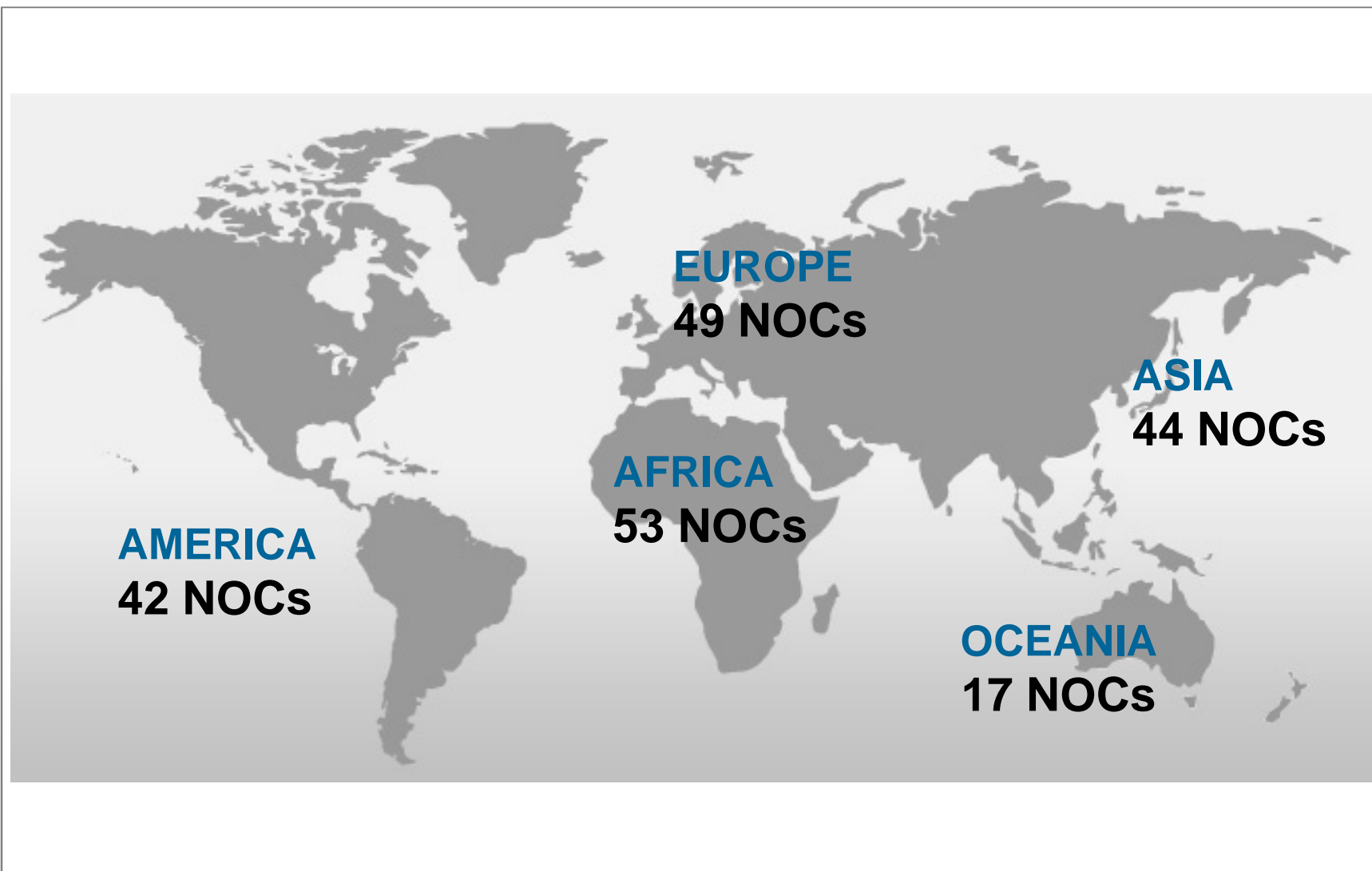

IFs

The mission of the **IFs** is to establish and enforce, in accordance with the Olympic spirit, the rules concerning the practice of their respective sports and to ensure their application & the development of their sports throughout the world; among others, the IF have to provide technical assistance in the practical implementation of the Olympic Solidarity programmes.

Olympic Solidarity is.....



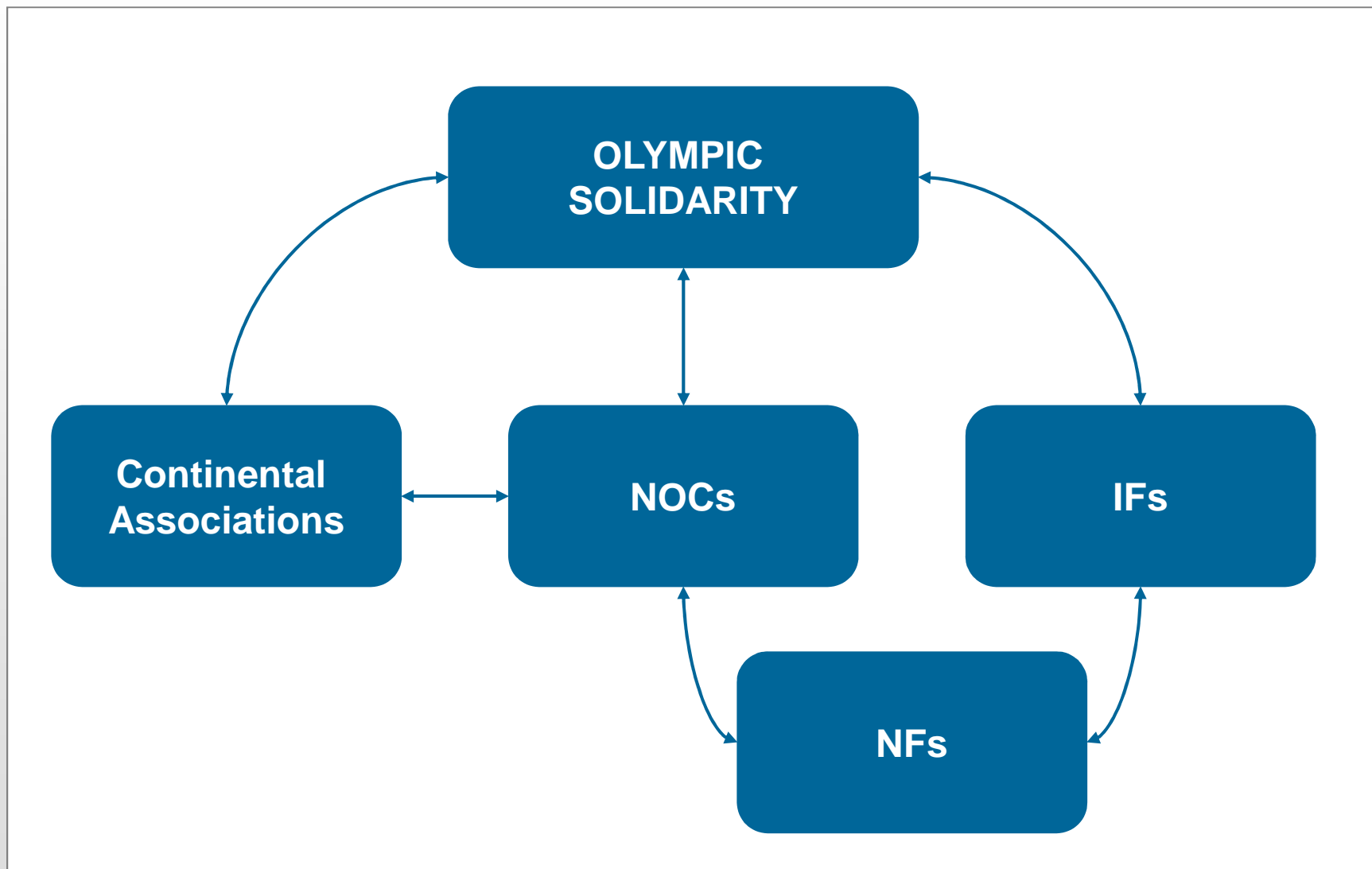
Responsible for managing and administering the share of the TV rights from the Olympic Games, which is allocated to the National Olympic Committees.

- A full information package (+ CD ROM) was sent to the International Federations in January 2009

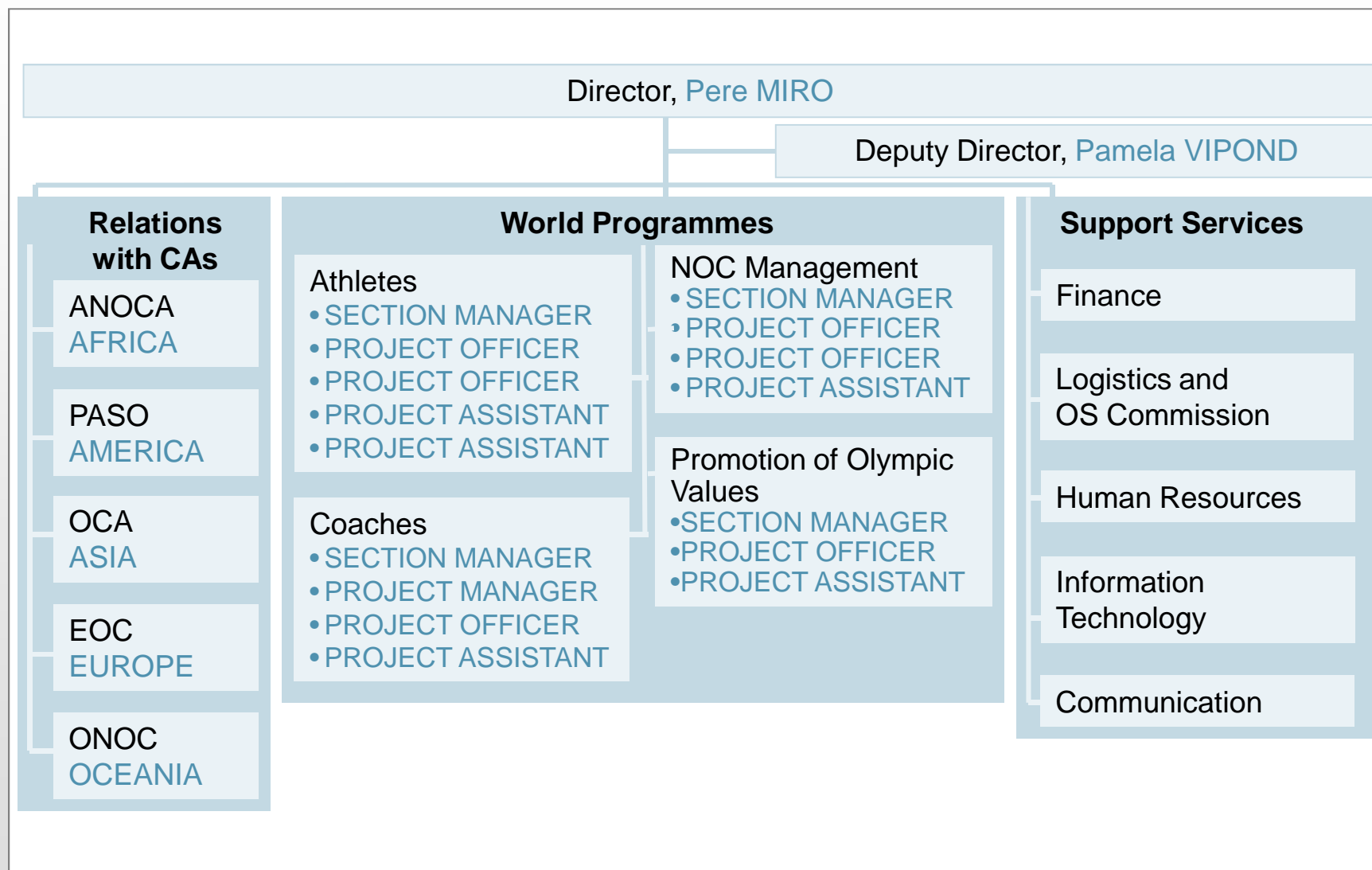

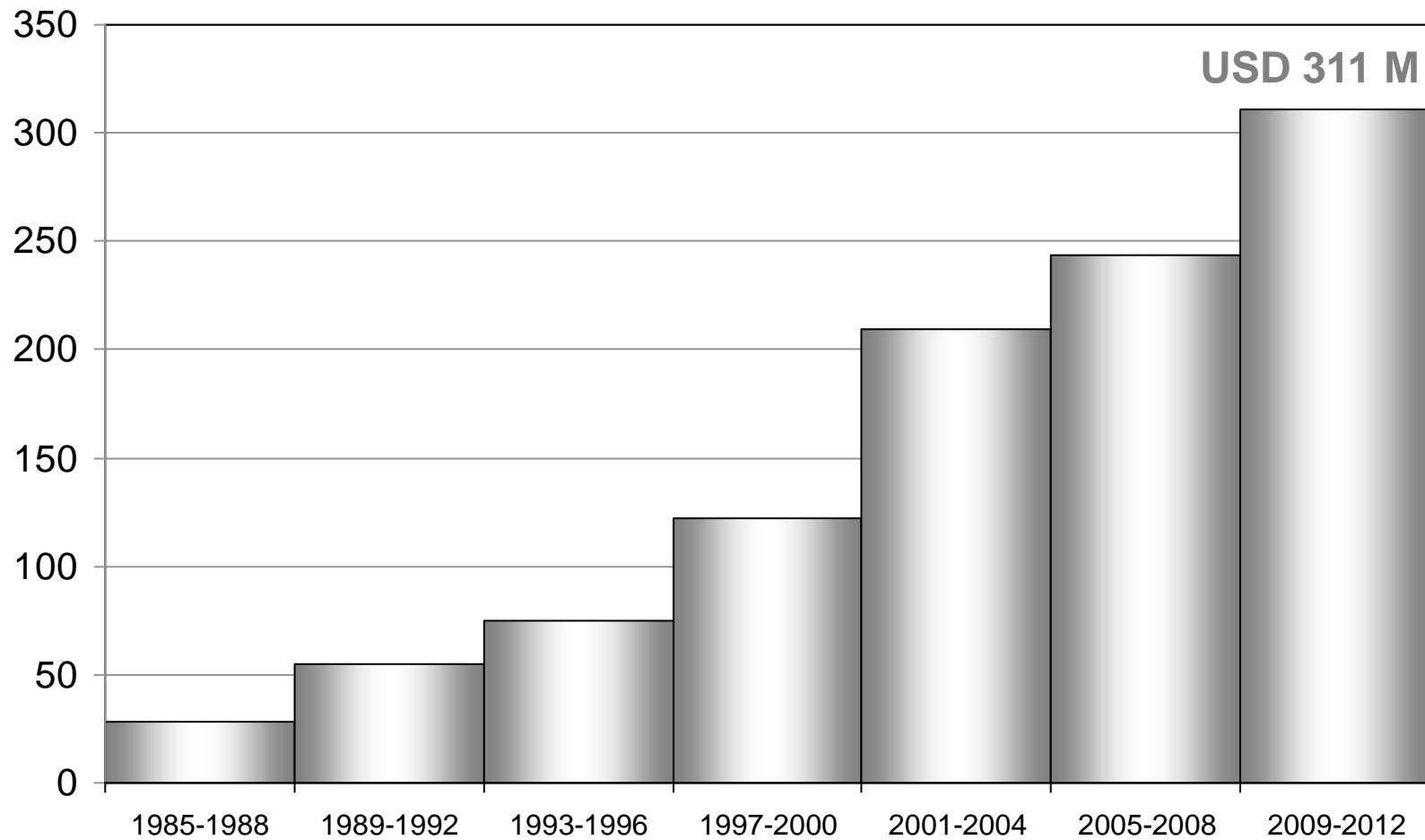

in million USD

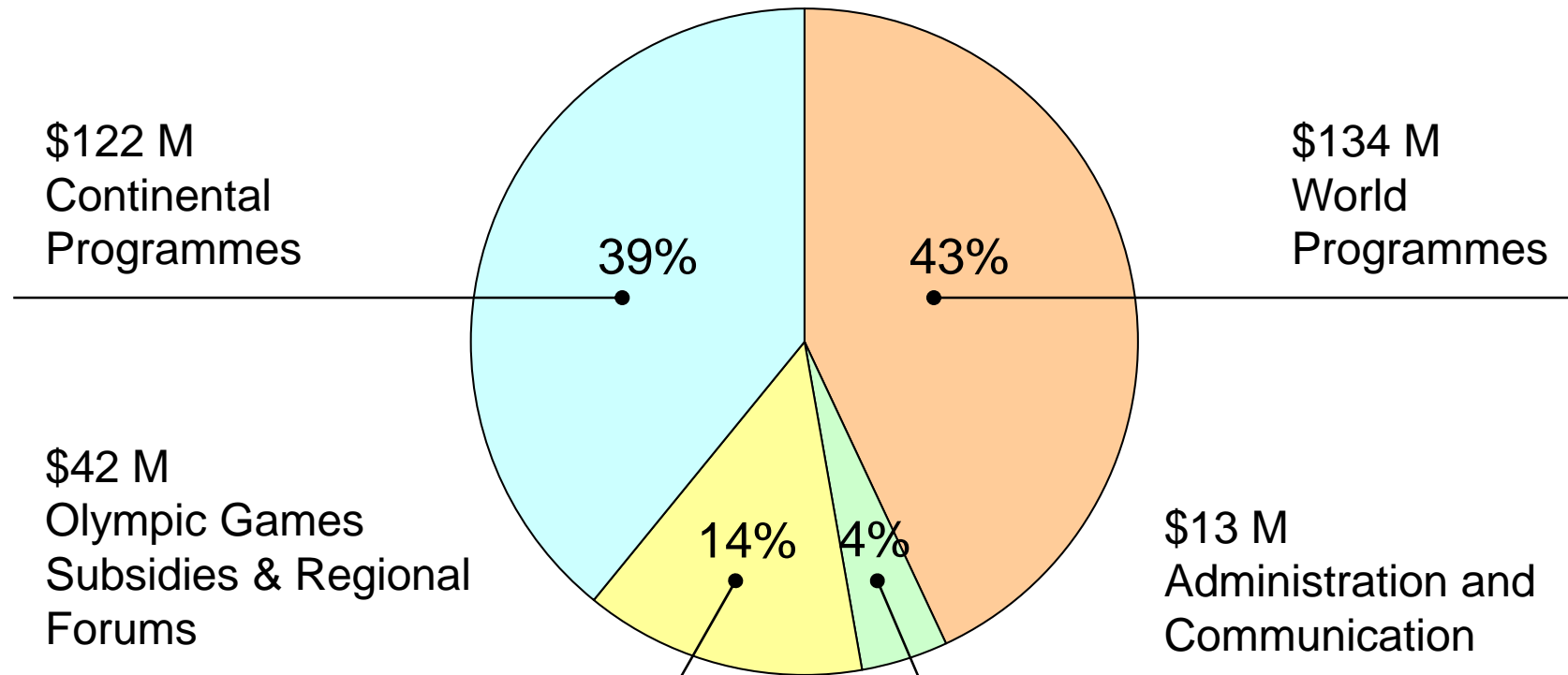


2009-2012 Quadrennial Budget

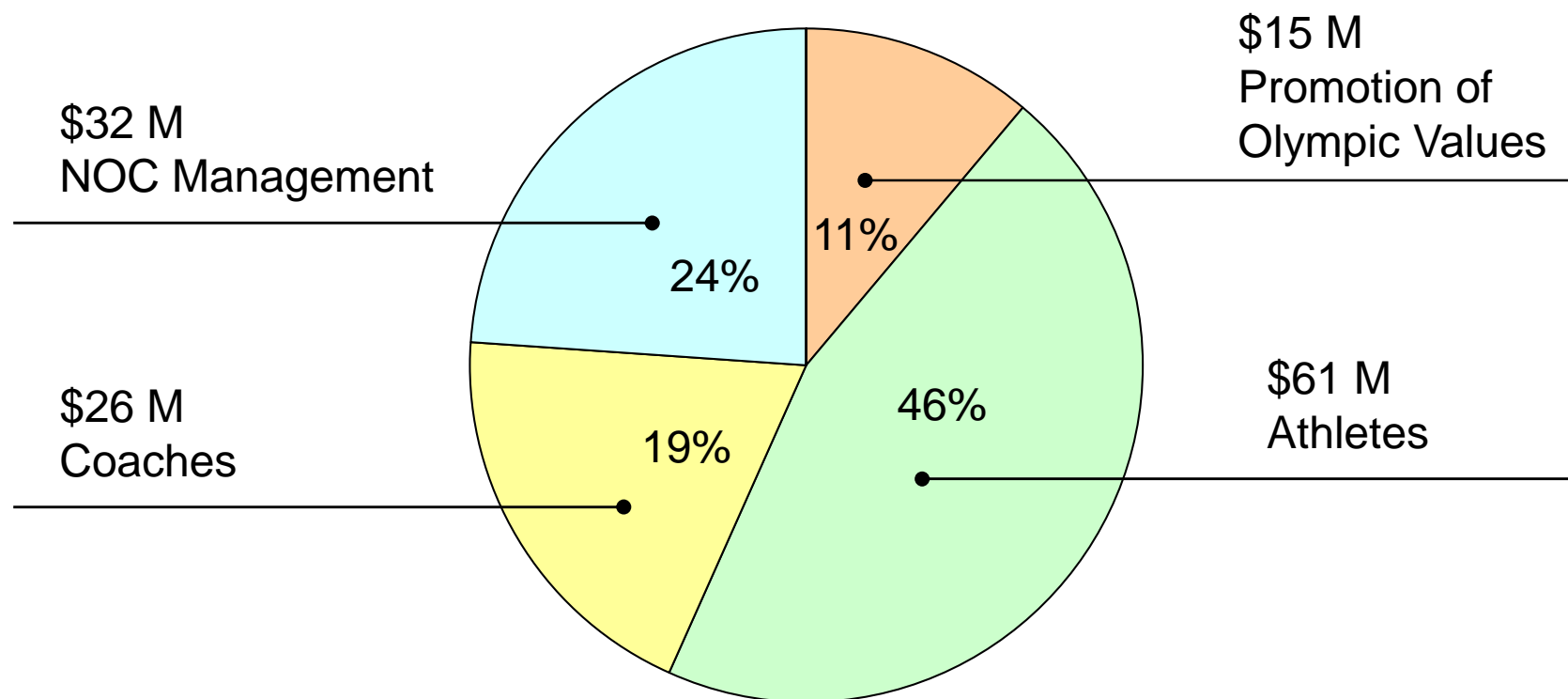
World Programmes Budget



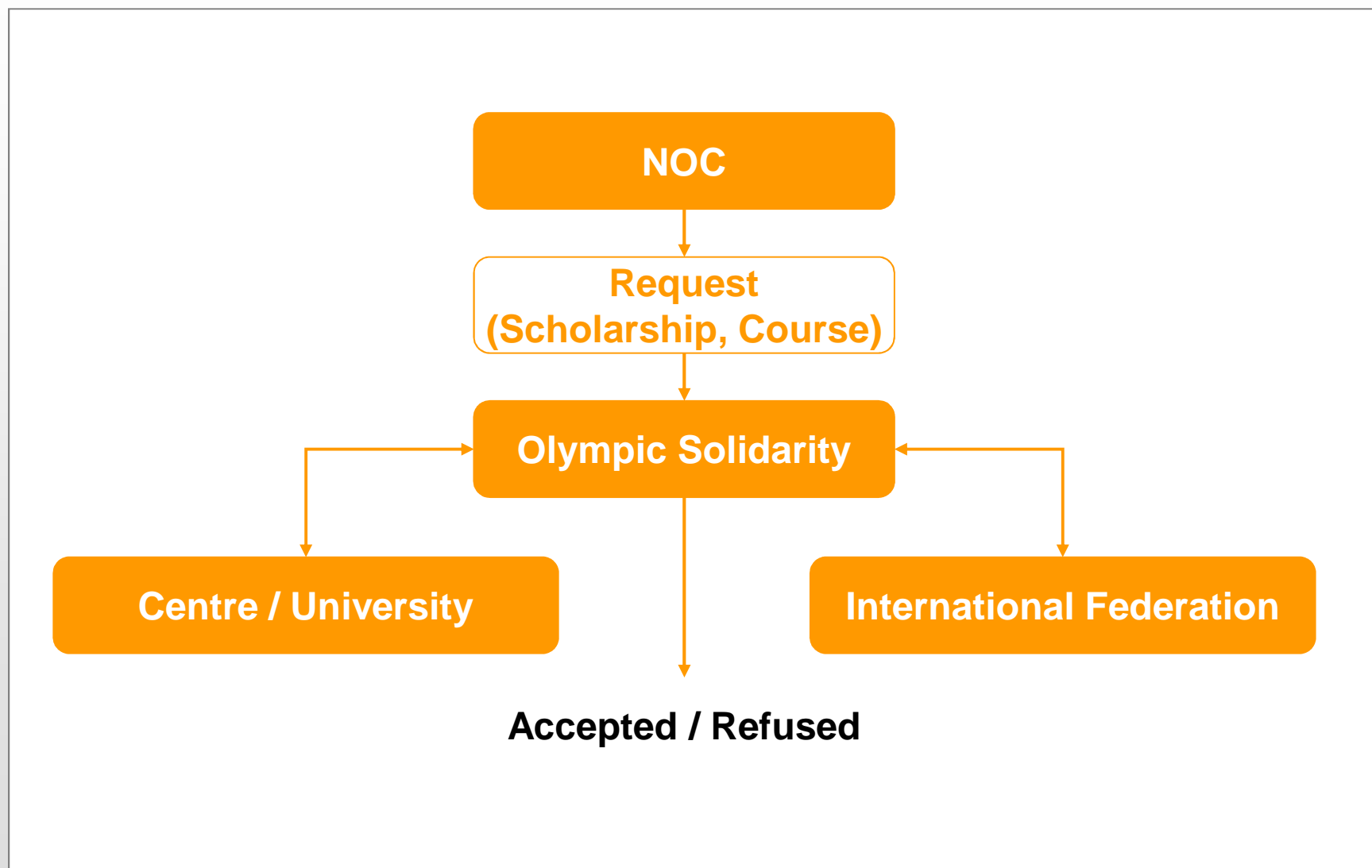

Olympic Scholarships for Athletes “London 2012”

- Similar the programme for Beijing Games (fixed monthly grant)
- A fixed amount of USD 5'000 will be available to each scholarship holder to cover air ticket costs to participate in Olympic qualification events.

Continental & Regional Games

- Assistance to athletes' preparations for multisport Games (Olympic, Continental and Regional)

Team Support Grants

- Assistance to 1 Winter and 1 Summer Team sport per NOC to prepare for Olympic Games Qualification



Youth Olympic Games – Athletes Preparation

- Merged “Training Grants for Young Athletes” and “Talent Identification” programmes
- **To identify** athletes: short national and international training camps
- **To qualify**: participate in qualifying events
- **To prepare**: final preparation for qualified athletes
- Available all quadrennial for all YOG editions
- Budget: USD 9M

- Traditional programme
- Basic level training
- All Olympic sports



Scholarships for Coaches

A. Training in Sports Sciences:

- « Academical » training.
- Courses organised by Universities or High level training centres.
- Average duration: 3 – 6 months.
- Results: diploma or certificate.

B. Sport specific training

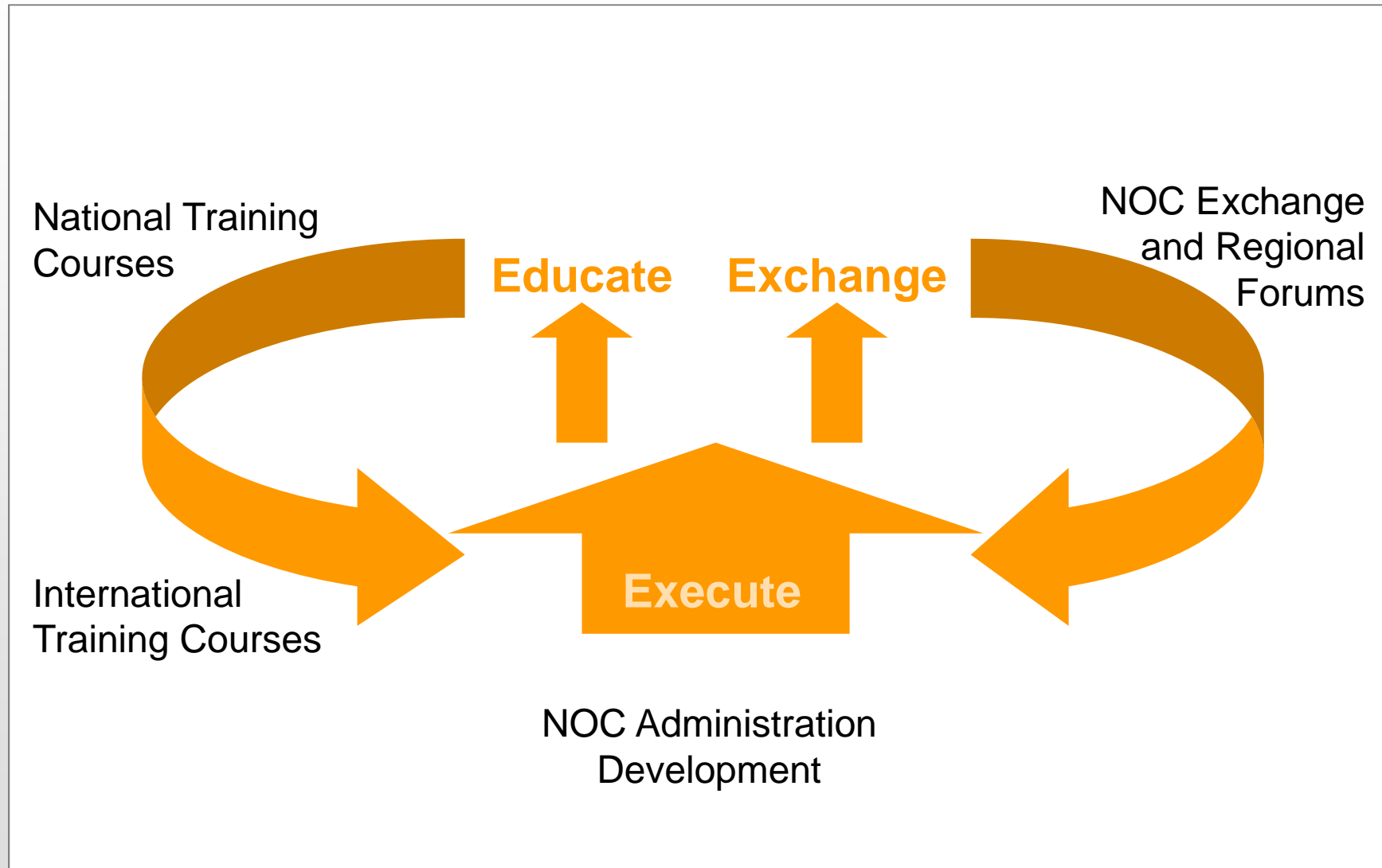
- Training in specific sports at a high level training centre/club.
- Average duration: 1 - 3 months.
- Technical and practical specialisation.



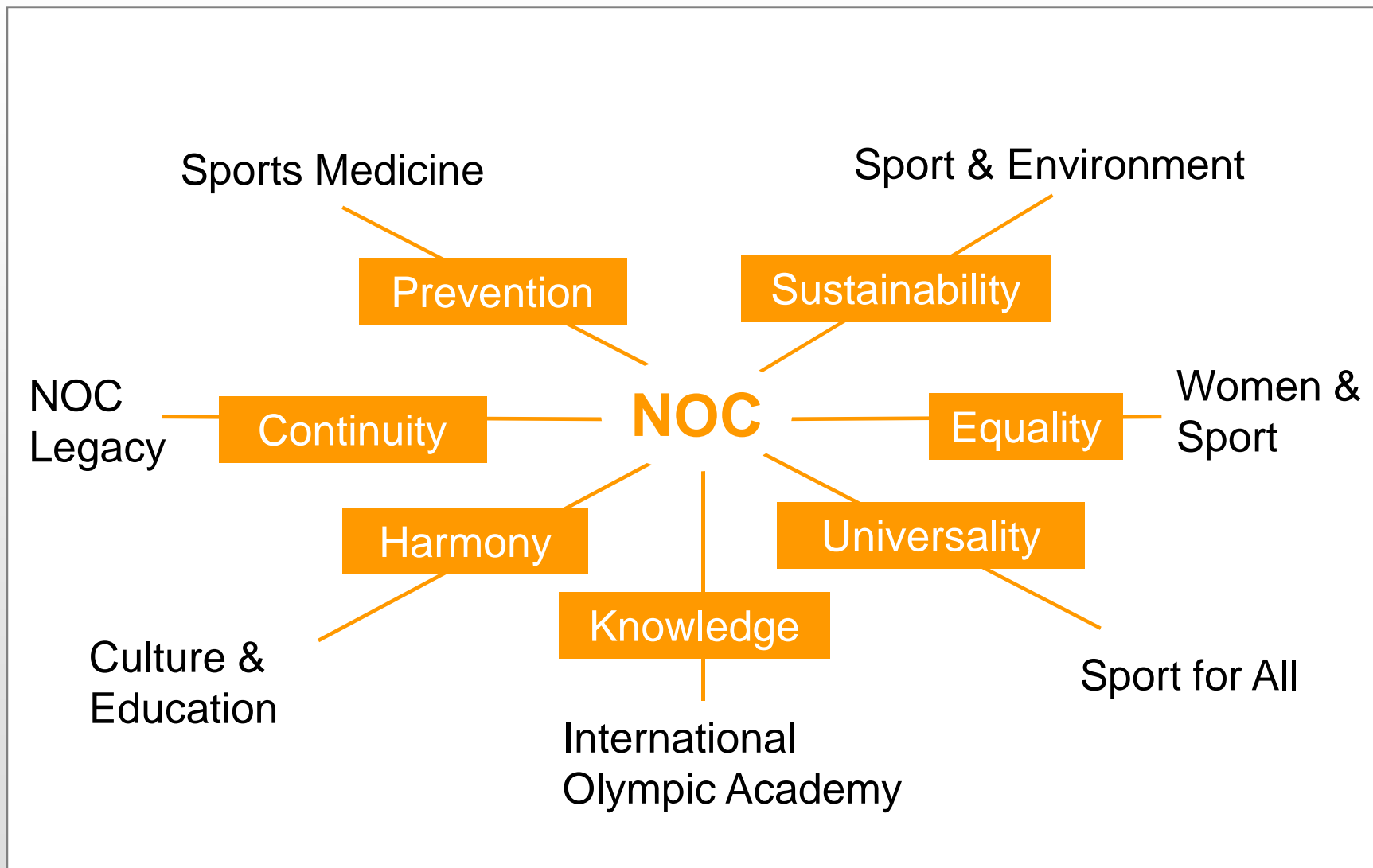
Development of National Sports Structure

Collaboration with IFs...



Olympic Solidarity consults the IFs on technical aspects of activities and projects proposed by the NOCs, in particular:

- athletes scholarships
- coaches scholarships
- nomination of experts for technical courses
- technical appraisal of NOC sports development projects

OS-FITA Collaboration 2005-2008...



Results

- A total of 60 activities were organised :
 - Africa : 14
 - America : 19
 - Asia : 16
 - Europe : 10
 - Oceania 1 (+ activities managed by ONOC)

OS-FITA Collaboration 2005-2008...



A total of USD 0.5 million was invested in the development of Archery through the OS programmes.

- Technical courses for coaches 16
